In addition to the above, the City of Oldsmar will be collecting a recreation card fee from each player/family:

\$ 5 plus tax Annual fee for Oldsmar residents

\$65 plus tax 6 month card for NON-Oldsmar residents

New this year—Safety Harbor Residents can pay \$5 as part of a reciprocal program between the two cities. Also, if you have a Clearwater, Dunedin, Largo or St. Pete recreation card you can bring it to the Oldsmar Municipal Center and get a 1-Year Oldsmar Recreation Card for only \$50!
